Pound Seizure Laws by State

States that mandate animals be released to research facilities = MN, OK, UT

States that ban pound seizure = CA, CT, DC, DE, HI, IL, ME, MD, MA, NH, NJ, NY, PA, RI, SC, VT, VA, WV

States that allow individual counties/shelters to decide on pound seizure = AZ, CO, IA, MI, OH, SD, TN, WI

States with no law on pound seizure = AL, AK, AR, FL, GA, ID, IN, KS, KY, LA, MS, MO, MT, NE, NV, NM, NC, ND, OR, TX, WA, WY
